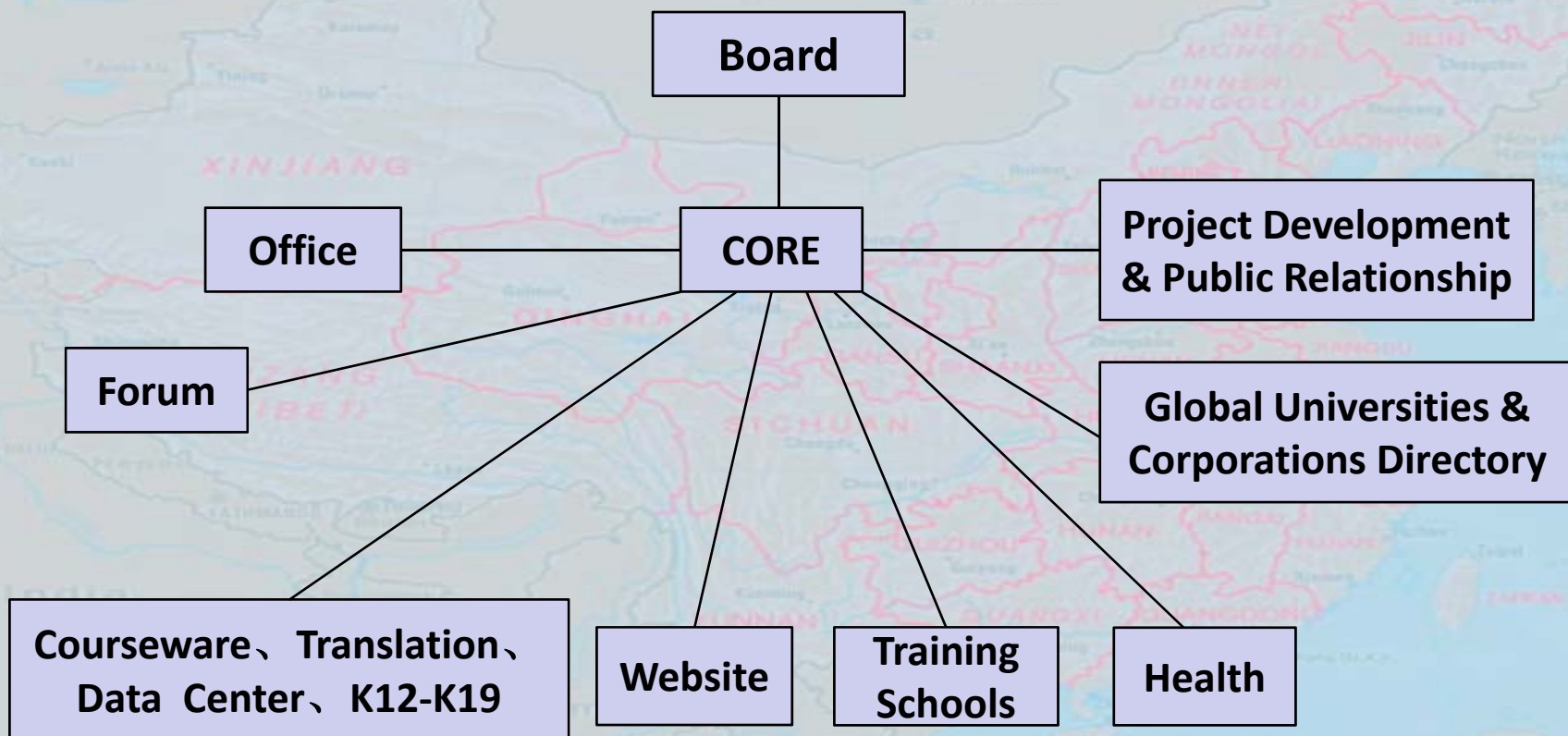

# 1. E-Learning Project (10 years ago)

Chinese government encouraged 67 key universities and colleges to create e-Learning schools.





## 2. Chinese Quality Open Course Ware (2003)

Chinese government created 1,500 Chinese Quality Open Course Ware (CQOCW) from 1,000 Chinese universities and are now published on university websites.



### **3. Excellence Project (2006 - 2011)**

Chinese government launched the “Excellence Project” which will assist university students to obtain skills and knowledge needed for a rapidly developing society.

Chinese universities and colleges have published 3,000 CQOCW online.



## 4. China Radio & Television University

(30 years ago)

Chinese central and provincial governments have established TV and Radio universities/colleges to pursue distance education in China.

Most have their on-line courses open and free.

The largest of these organizations has 3.3 million students.



## 5. Cooperative Community Associations (past few years)

Many Chinese universities/colleges established cooperative community associations to share OER and teaching, libraries, equipment and classrooms.



## 6. Education Reform & Development (March 2010)

The Chinese government published the “National Outline for Medium and Long-Term Education Reform and Development”.

It stressed “Equality Education” to eliminate the disparity between the urban and rural communities.

The goal is to build a learning society that allows everyone access to learn anytime and any place.



## 7. Online Higher Education with Diploma (2010)

The Chinese Ministry of Education formalized the program in 68 universities/colleges designed for the part-time education of adult employees.

The schools must make their online courses open and freely accessible.



## CORE Accomplishments

- Encouraged universities to collaborate and become OCWC university
- Comparative Studies completed on over 200 MIT OCW Courses vs. Chinese Courses
- 3,000 Quality Chinese OCW
- 7,000 OCW from Individual Universities
- Total of 10,000 OCW Course that CORE had some influence in making available in China and shared Internationally
- 12 Lead Universities
- 100 Member Universities
