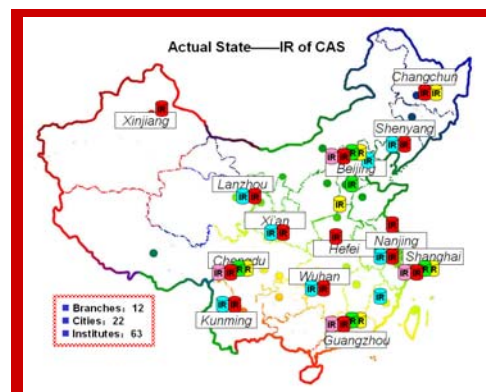
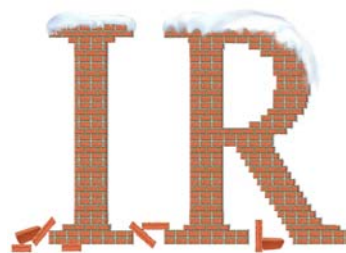

## Promotion & Construction

### Introduction

Knowledge management has become an important part of Digital Scientific Research of the Chinese Academy of Sciences. The National Science Library of CAS (NSL) developed the CAS-IR technology platform and promoted the application of CAS-IR in individual institutes of the Chinese Academy of Sciences. The goal is to assist the institutes in building their own knowledge storage and use platform, and to promote Institute information service transformation and innovation development. This process has a positive effect on the construction of digital information, long-term preservation, and service mechanism in the whole CAS, and will improve management efficiency of scientific research in CAS.



### Objects

The National Science Library aligned subject librarians and technical support teams to collaborate with institute staff. NSL teams assisted the institutes in enhancing scientific research and knowledge management services, and also hopes to provide a supporting base for the institute libraries and librarians to develop service innovation and capability strengthening.

Objectives include:

1. Select a number of institutes based on their high level of commitment to build institutional knowledge storage (IR) systems.
2. Collaborate with the institute to develop institutional knowledge management practices.
3. Promote the upgrading of the institute library and information service, and promote institute knowledge management.

### Principles and Guidelines

- IR promotion priority is *service*.
- Individual institute leads the construction.
- Collaboration between the NSL and institutes.
- Two construction modes: agreement or trial
- Established management practices and promoted the knowledge sharing: provide sustained support and policy support for the technology, specification and staff.

### Results and Discussion

At the end of the Sept. 2010, **63 institutes** have developed their institute IR s.

We are still working hard to:

- Upgrade system and supply a more perfect technology platform
- Supply service to meet the institute individual needs
- Continue to promote, improve our service to meet higher standards
- Enlist support from individual users and all managerial levels
